

RESOLUTION REMH Nº 001/2008 – ACADEMIC DIRECTORATE September 22th 2008

APPROVES RULES TO THE STUDIES' COMPLETION IN THE EURO-AMERICAN STRICTO SENSU POS-GRADUATION PROGRAMME'S SCOPE AMONG OTHER PROVISIONS.

The secretary General of Rede Euro-americana de Motricidade Humana, using their legal and procedural powers, *ad referendum* of General Assembly, Considering :

- The Euro-American Post Graduation Stricto Sensu Programme will have it's sustainability and credibility based on the quality of the scientific production of the candidates to master and doctorate.
- The students with regular registration in the PEPGS-REMH, which have activated and regular registration, have the right of continuation of the respective graduation, respecting the time limits specified in the of PEPGS Regulation.
- The Academic Directorate is, in compliance of it's procedural powers, in charge of define and communicate the time limit to the integration of academic activities of graduation of the mentioned students in the last topic.
- This process of graduation must to be conducted from the unrestricted observation of the procedures, indicatives and the criterion of adequacy and quality required by the international scientific community.
- The Directorate members of Rede Euro-americana de Motricidade Humana were consulted.

RESOLVES:

1st Article: The regular registered students in each one of the convocations of PEPGS, must to make the Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis in, at least, six months before the end of the time limit for formal link of the respective convocations and have the right to continue the process of integration of the respective programmes .

1st Paragraph: Unusually for students of the 1st convocation, is set the deadline for up to six months after the end of the regular term of formal ties to hold Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis.

2nd Paragraph : To students of first Convocation who use the time limit granted in the first paragraph will be charged the cost of six monthly parcels of 1/3 of the respective monthly fee. Additional extensions will be always in the time limit and conditions mentioned in this paragraph.

2nd Article: Necessary conditions to require the Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation/Thesis:

- I- The definitive version presentation of the draft of Dissertation/Thesis
- II- The supervisor's agreement, in writing, that the Project has the appropriate academic conditions.
- III- The project approval by the Committee of Ethics and Research and;
- IV- Attesting the publication of an article about the subject of Dissertation/Thesis in scientific journal can be done by the presentation of the published article or by a letter of acceptance written by the journal's editor.

3rd Article: Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis will be used in front of the board of examination constituted by three specialists with graduation at least in doctorate level and one of them will be a professor of the University previously approval by the Academic Directorate.

1st PARAGRAPH: To the Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis , the physical presence of the examiners can be replaced for a report, in writing, at the discretion of the supervisor.

2nd Paragraph: The approved students in the Doctorate's Qualification Exam and those who have been approved in all subjects of the programme, will receive an Advanced Studies Diploma.

4th Article: The Project for Dissertation should disclose relevant information about the topic and the problem of research, its goals, its questions or hypotheses to investigate the relevance of the research, the theoretical framework or review of the literature on the topic/problem and detailed specification of the methodology of the research.

5th Article: The articles that deal with the previous articles, necessarily related to the subject of the dissertation should be written by the student and be published with the supervisor's approval .

6th Article: Students who do not meet the requirements for claiming the Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis or who were not qualified in the mentioned exam, will be officially disjointed of PEPGS-REMH, doing justice to a declaration of disciplines that studied, issued by the University in which it is registered, respecting the existing legislation.

7th Article: Students approved in the qualification examination of the Draft dissertations/thesis, that are regularly registered after completion with approval of respective disciplines, must defend his dissertation / thesis until the end of the regular term of formal linkage of its convocation To get their titles .

Single Paragraph: Students who do not complete their studies until the end of the stipulated period of its convocation should request an extension of term, which if granted, will result in charge of six monthly installments of 1 / 3 of the value of their monthly fee. Additional extensions will be always in time and in the conditions cited in this paragraph.

8th Article: Necessary conditions to request the exam of Defense of Dissertation masters or doctoral thesis:

- I- the presentation of the final version of Dissertation / Thesis, formatted in accordance with the standards of REMH;
- II- Concordance of the supervisor, in writing, saying that the dissertation / thesis is in line with the academic conditions.
- III- The presentation of the Diploma of Advanced Studies - DEA, in the case of doctorate, and;
- IV- Attesting the publication of another article about the topic of the Dissertation, in journal indexed in LILACS, Site, Sport Discus or Lantindex and the thesis in the journal indexed SCOPUS, PubMed or ISI. Such proof could be done through the presentation of the article published or through a letter of acceptance from the editor of the journal

9th Article: The Examination for the Defense of Dissertation / Thesis will be carried out, necessarily in the native language, in the country seat of the University which is linked to the student, preferably to the same board of examination of the Qualification Examination of the Draft Dissertation / Thesis. In case of impeachment of any member of the board of qualification, an indication of the examiner substitute is the responsibility of the Academic Director of REMH.

Single Paragraph: All costs of academic fees, transportation, accommodation and food for members of the board's examination will be on behalf of candidates.

10th Article: The students with leave of absence or in irregular financial situation must reopen the registration necessarily, within the stipulated period for renewal of registrations relating to the second semester. Failure to reopening the registration in regulatory deadline will mean the shutdown of its students of PEPGS-REMH.

11th Article: Abandonment of course or financial default, will characterize, by the student, his shutdown of the program

12th Article: This Resolution becomes an integral part of the Regulation of the Euro-American Stricto Sensu Post Graduation Programme. It is repealing the provision to the contrary.

13th Article: This Resolution becomes worth on the date on it's published date.
